Goal 1 Attendance

In the 2017-2018 school year, BMS will have 85% of our students on track by the end of the school year. We will reduce the percentage of students at some risk by 75% by the end of the school year. As a sub goal,

we want to increase the percentage of SpEd students on track to 75% on track.
