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Goals and Action Plans for Butler Middle School's CSIP 2016-2017

Literacy Performance Goals:

- 1) Increase our school-wide reading proficiency to 80% in the advanced and proficient ranges as measured by the SRI. 8th Grade 80%; 7th Grade 80%; 6th Grade 75%
- 2) ELA SAGE to show a MGP of 60 in the ELA 2017 SAGE.

STEM Performance Goals:

- 1) Math SAGE to show a MGP of 65 in the 2017 SAGE.
- 2) Science SAGE to show a MGP of 65 in the 2017 SAGE.

PBIS Performance Goal:

- 1) Score of at least 80% on the TFI, measuring implementation and knowledge of school-wide PBIS plan.
 - 2) Collect and analyze Educators Handbook and Great Bruin Card data.
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1. Welcome

- Lisa Boyce proposed the approval of the minutes from the last meeting and Paula Logan seconded the motion. All in favor of the approval.

2. Bylaws

- Two (2) adjustments need to be made to the Bylaw wording as a result of law changes;
 - the number of parent member's vs employee members need to be changed from 2 more members to now only need 1 more member...
 - The Co-Chair needs to be changed to Vice-Chair, and this position can be held by either a parent OR an employee.
- Michael Albrecht has resigned as a member of the community counsel.

- The parent group voted unanimously to appoint one of the alternates.
- There are 2 alternates: Paula Faerber and Robert Leonard. Paula Logan will **contact Paula Faerber** to see if she can fill Michael's position on the committee.
- Paula Logan will **post the Land Trust Budget** on the school website per the bylaws.

3. Land Trust Report Budget

- Paula reviewed the data from the Land Trust report (see attached).
- The money was spent in the following areas:
 - After school tutoring
 - \$8,000-\$10,000 was set aside for school wide Professional Development.
 - Literacy Strategies, Tiered reading classes and academic aids
 - We didn't use as much money as planned so we did get some money back.
 - Hired aides to track students and help with after school tutoring.
 - Paid the math teachers for after school tutoring on Tuesdays and Thursdays in their classrooms.
 - \$500 was used to purchase MobyMax, a math program the kids can access at home for additional math help.
 - **Paula will have data for the next meeting**
 - Extra money used to purchase Chromebook labs.

4. Review CSIP adjustments this year as a result of SAGE and SRI data

- SRI: We saw a 12-17% increase in all grade levels.
- Changes to goals were approved by the BLT and are updated on the agenda.

5. SRI/SMI Data Review (see attached):

- The SMI (Scholastic Math Inventory) is a new test, the fall data will be used as a Benchmark. The test is like a Pre-Test
- Goals were adjusted based on the Fall information

6. Middle School Scheduling Task Force Report

- The district is looking into making some changes to the middle school schedule. They are looking at a few different options; a 10, 7 or 6 period schedule. They are leaning towards either the 6 (leaving it as is) or the 7 period schedule.
 - The 7 period schedule makes it harder for "Teaming", but students have more elective class options.
 - The 6 period schedule (current) allows for true teaming and students have more time in their core classes.

- There will be a presentation for teachers on Friday, November 4th at Eastmont Middle. The plan will be presented to the School Board on November 15th.
- Paula will send the ppt presentation to the SCC.

7. Cell Tower Funding 2016-2017

- Cell tower money is spent on the following:
 - CANVAS incentive
 - Sound Grading
 - Field trips/busses
 - Teacher meals for trainings, PT&Me, and
 - Waffle Wednesday
 - Custodial Help
- Lisa D motioned to approve cell tower funding. Lisa B seconded it.
- The vote to approve was unanimous.
